



Job-Site Safety Institute (JSI) Exhibitor Grant Program: 2024 IBS Jobsite Safety Zone

PURPOSE

The JSI Exhibitor Grant Program provides support to qualified safety product and service exhibitors at the International Builders' Show (IBS) Jobsite Safety Zone to collaborate and exchange ideas to increase awareness of the inherent dangers of a construction site or potential risks in the construction industry. Taking place February 27–29, 2024 in Las Vegas, NV, the IBS Jobsite Safety Zone showcases exhibitors who are committed and dedicated to innovation in the construction industry with cutting edge construction safety products, equipment, and services. There is a unique opportunity for suppliers to educate residential construction professionals on the latest in workplace safety solutions.



CRITERIA

JSI will provide Exhibitor Grants to qualifying organizations who meet the following criteria:

- The Exhibitor Grant Program is open to first time 2024 IBS Jobsite Safety Zone Exhibitors or Exhibitors who have not participated at the IBS in the last 5 years.
- Exhibitors must be engaged in providing construction safety and health solutions (i.e., equipment, products, services and/or supplies) designed to help protect workers from jobsite hazards.
- JSI will provide a grant of \$20 per sq. ft., with a maximum amount of \$2000.00 for an Exhibitor in the Jobsite Safety Zone.
- Exhibitors must complete a grant request form and include proof of the safety-related products, goods, services, supplies, or equipment to be displayed in the 2024 IBS Jobsite Safety Zone.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Any Grant to a potential IBS Jobsite Safety Zone Exhibitor who is dedicated to innovation in safety practices in the construction industry is preconditioned on proof of payment to be included in the 2024 IBS Jobsite Safety Zone.
- A JSI Grant will be paid no sooner than 30-days after the conclusion of the 2024 IBS.
- Any potential JSI Grant is preconditioned on the presentation and exhibition of equipment, products, services or supplies that focus on or demonstrate safety features that are designed to protect workers from jobsite hazards. Equipment, products, services or supplies that are not intended to promote safety would not satisfy the requirements for a JSI Grant. JSI reserves the right to decline an application if the products either: (1) do not meet the safety-focused requirements outlined above; or (2) the Exhibitor cancels its exhibit in the Job Site Safety Zone or (3) the Exhibitor does not maintain their exhibit for the throughout the February 27-29, 2024 IBS.
